Over 50% of people who abuse prescription pain relievers get them from friends or family.

Prescription and over-the-counter drugs are the most commonly misused substances by Americans age 14 and older, after marijuana and alcohol.

EPA studies have detected pharmaceutical drugs in our water supply.

What is Collected?

Old Prescriptions—remember to remove any personal information from bottles.

Pet Medications

There may be some restrictions on injectables, inhalers and liquid

What happens to the medications?

Medications are picked up and disposed of properly by the DEA.

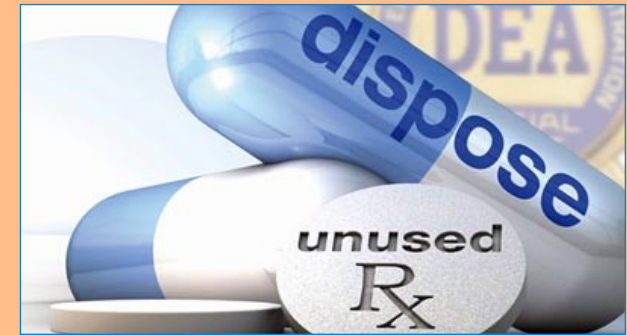
